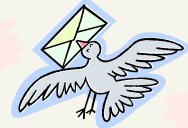

Notice of the first budget meeting must be published in the paper (or mailed or hand-delivered) twice at least seven (7) days apart and not sooner than five (5) days nor longer than thirty (30) days prior to the first meeting. Notice of subsequent meetings do not have to be published but must be posted, either individually or in one single posting, and notice must comply with ORS 294.406.

If public testimony is not received at the first meeting, along with the budget message, opportunity must be provided at subsequent meetings. Notice of at least the first meeting at which public testimony will be received must be published. Notice of meetings should include a statement regarding handicapped accessibility.

WHAT'S NEW IN PLANNING - PUBLIC HEARING: MILL CITY MASTER PARKS PLAN

Notice is hereby given that the Planning Commission and City Council will hold a joint public hearing to review the following proposal to amend the Mill City Comprehensive Plan:

File 2014.01 Parks Master Plan. The City proposes to adopt a parks master plan as a technical amendment to the Mill City Comprehensive Plan. The parks master plan includes comprehensive plan policies for the redevelopment and improvement of parks and recreation facilities inside the Mill City Urban Growth Boundary. The adoption of the plan will enable the City to apply for federal and state

grants. New developments will be required to comply with the plan.

The hearings will take place during a regular meeting of the City Council to be held on Tuesday, February 25, 2014 during the regularly scheduled council meeting beginning at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall, 444 N. First Avenue, Mill City, Oregon. The proposed plan, maps, decision criteria and staff report are available at City Hall. Any person wishing to provide testimony must address the decision criteria. Failure to raise an issue precludes appeal and failure to specify to which criterion the com-

ment is directed precludes appeal based on that criterion.

City Hall is accessible to persons with disabilities. Please call City Hall ([503-897-2302](tel:503-897-2302)) by noon the day before the meeting if you need an interpreter for the hearing impaired or any other special accommodation. Linn County Sheriff's Office neighborhood Watch Liaison Jim Lepin has been hard at work, assisting local groups in their endeavors to start Neighborhood Watch in their respective neighborhoods.

Mr. Lepin has stated that there are five active Neighborhood Watch groups in Mill City. Between these groups and the four informational forums held at City Hall there have been over 70 citizens participating since October. On Tuesday, March 4, 2014 at 6:30p.m. the individual Neighborhood Watch groups will hold a joint meeting in the Mill City Elem-

entary School library. Captain Kevin Guilford of the Linn County Sheriff's Office as well as a narcotics detective, are scheduled to attend this meeting to discuss progress with current crime reduction efforts and specific needs of the community as we work together to reduce crime within Mill City. BENTON ALERT**

The **Linn-Benton ALERT** Emergency Notification System is a mass notification system that allows public safety officials to provide rapid notifications to Linn and Benton County residents of emergencies, evacuations, and other urgent events. By signing up for the **Linn-Benton ALERT** Emergency Notification System, you will receive time-sensitive emergency and safety alerts from public safety officials in the county where you work or live. You may choose how and where to receive alerts, including your cell, home, and/or work phone; by email, text messages, or TTY (hearing impaired devices) and more.
